

2018 EXAMINATION RESULTS

I am pleased to report a very strong set of examination results for Chadwell Heath Academy. Congratulations must go to our staff and pupils upon their excellent performance. All of these achievements are based upon the hard work and commitment of the teachers and their pupils. They also reflect the effectiveness of our monitoring and support systems and the positive atmosphere of ambition that permeates the school. It is important to recognise that our performance is strong throughout the ability range and the results for our disadvantaged pupils are very strong. This reflects our ethos of ensuring that all pupils are nurtured and supported irrespective of their ability, needs or background. None of this would be possible without the support of our parents and governors for which we are most grateful.

GCSE:

- The average grade across all GCSE's is 5.3 (strong pass)
- The average grade across all GCSE's is 5 for disadvantaged pupils (strong pass)
Note (4 = C grade and 5.5 = B grade)
- Grade 4 or better in English & Mathematics 78%. Disadvantaged 67%
- Grade 5 or better in English and Mathematics 54%. Disadvantaged 48%

Our success has been consistent throughout the ability range, of the 1635 grades awarded:

- 12% were A**, A*, 9, 8 or above.
- 24% were A/7 or above.
- 45% were A*, A, B, 9, 8, 7, 6 or above.
- 81% were C/4 or above.
- 98% of our students achieved 5+ A*/9 to G/1 grades.
- Only 8% of the grades awarded were below a D/3.

Sixth Form: The 98% pass rate at A-level is an outstanding performance for a school that has an open access 6th form and I am proud to report that many students who would not be able to take A-levels in other schools have achieved their dreams and are going to university. Our BTEC results are similarly outstanding producing an average grade of distinction.

Destinations: 130 out 137 who applied to university have accepted places, the rest have not taken up offers at this stage. Our students are going on to attend at a wide range of institutions including LSE, Kings, Queen Mary, and Manchester, taking a variety of courses including Pharmacy, Mathematics, Economics, Law, History, English and Mathematics.

The value of the CTEC courses has really made its mark this year with students going on to universities such as Northampton and Kent. Those who combined two traditional A levels with a CTEC have come out with three and a half level three qualifications gaining more UCAS points

than many who did three straight A levels, going on to study a range of subjects including B Ed and Architecture.

Some students have chosen to take up apprenticeships including one very prestigious post at the bank of England.

All of this demonstrates the quality of our careers advice and UCAS support programme.
